

TOOLS YOU'LL need

- A pencil
- Paint markers
- Scissors
- Paint brushes
 (varying in size
 for different kinds of detail work)

materials you'll need

- Plain ceramic baubles
- Acrylic paint (in your favourite Bluey colours)
- •Ribbon (approx. 15cm long)






Instructions:

1) Using a wide paintbrush, paint the base layer of colour on to the bauble. You may want to do more than one coat of paint. Have somewhere ready where you can hang the bauble to dry.

2) With a pencil sketch your design on to the bauble (I found it easiest to outline the sketch with the paint marker!).










Instructions (cont'd):

3) Time to paint the design! Paint each colour one at a time and leave time to dry. Alternatively, if you have many different colour paint pens, you can use these to colour in the character instead of acrylic paint. Once dry, outline the design with a paint pen. Leave to dry.







- 4) Optional step: do the same thing and create a new design on the other sides of the bauble. This could be a star, a candy cane, a Christmas tree, or even another Bluey character!
- 5) Carefully, cut off the original string that was on the bauble and replace with a nice piece of ribbon.
- 6) Now your bauble is ready to be used for decoration!
