

TOOLS YOU'LL need

- · 3.5mm crochet hook
- Yarn Needle
- Sewing Needle
- Thread
- Scissors



materials you'll need

- 50grams light blue 8ply yarn (for the body, feet and tail)
- Small amounts of 8ply yarn in:
 - o Pink (for the ears)
 - o Purple (for the nose)
 - o Dark Blue (for the eyes and mouth)
- Small piece of grey material (for the patch)
- Polyfill for stuffing the body and feet

SUITABLE FOR BEGINNERS

ABBREVIATIONS

MR = Magic Ring

= Chain

= Slip Stitch

DC = Double Crochet

DEC = Decrease

INC = Increase

NOTES

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- The whole project is facing out and completed in the round.
- The total amount of stitches you should have will be in brackets at the end of each row. So if you see (20) at the end of the row, you should have 20 stitches in the row.
- Any repeated actions within a row will also be in brackets, alongside the amount of times that action will be taken in that row. Example,, (2dc, inc) x 10 means two double crochets then increase on the third, repeat this ten times.



WE USE THE TERM DOUBLE CROCHET IN THIS PATTERN, BUT YOU MIGHT CALL IT A SINGLE CROCHET WHERE YOU LIVE.



PART ONE: HEAD AND BODY

(LIGHT BLUE YARN)



- **2)** dc inc around (16)
- **3)** (1 dc. 1 dc inc) x 8 (24)
- **4)** (2 dc. 1 dc inc) x 8 (32)
- **5)** dc even (32)
- **6)** (3 dc. 1 dc inc) x 8 (40)
- **7–47)** dc even (40)
- **48)** (8 dc, 1 dc dec) x 4 (36)
- **49)** dc even (36)
- **50)** (6 dc, 1 dc dec) x 4, then 4dc (32) **57)** dc dec around (8)



- **51)**dc even (32)
- **52)** (4 dc. 1 dc dec) x 5. then 2dc (27)
- **53)** dc even (27)
- **54)** (3 dc. 1 dc dec) x 5, then 2 dc (22)
- **55)** dc even (22)
- **56)** (1 dc, 1 dc dec) x 7, then 1 dc (15)

FINISH, STUFF THE BODY WITH THE POLYFILL AND **CLOSE THE HOLE.**



PART TWO: NOSE (PURPLE YARN)

EMBROIDER THE NOSE WITH PURPLE YARN





PART THREE: EARS

(PINK YARN - MAKE TWO)

- **1)** 8 dc in a mr (8)
- **3)** dc even (12)
- **5)** dc even (14)
- **6)** (5 dc. 1 dc dec) x 2 (12)

- **7)** dc even (12)
- **2)** (1 dc, 1 dc inc) x 4 (12) **8)** (4 dc, 1 dc dec) x 2 (10)
 - **9)** dc even (10)
- **4)** (5 dc, 1 dc inc) x 2 (14) **10)** (3 dc, 1 dc dec) x 2 (8)

DO NOT STUFF THE EAR. FLATTEN THE EAR AND CROCHET THROUGH BOTH LAYERS. Leave a Long Tail of yar to sew the ear on



PART FOUR: LEGS (LIGHT BLUE YARN - MAKE 4)

- **1)** 6 dc in a mr (6)
- **2)** dc inc around (12)
- **3-4)** dc even (12)
- **5)** Work 6dc and leave the other 6 stitches unworked (6)





FINISH OFF AND LEAVE A LONG TAIL OF YARN TO SEW THE LEG BENEATH THE BODY. THE LEG SHOULD BE POSITIONED SO THAT THE 6SC OF THE LAST ROUND ARE POINTING OUTWARDS.



PART FIVE: TAIL (LIGHT BLUE YARN)

- **1)** 4dc in a mr (4)
- **2)** 1 dc, 2 dc inc, 1 dc (6)
- **3)** 2 dc, 2 dc inc, 2 dc (8)
- **4-10)** sc even (8)
- **11)** 3 dc. 2 dc inc. 3 dc (10)

FINISH OFF and Leave a Long Tail of Yarn To Sew Tail on.

PART SIX: EYES AND MOUTH

(DARK BLUE YARN)

Sew the eyes and mouth as shown in the photo.







PART FIVE: PATCH (GREY FABRIC)

CUT OUT 2 PIECES OF FABRIC IN A ROUGH HEART SHAPE FOR THE PATCH.

Make Sure you include a margin around the finished size for the seam allowance.

STITCH AROUND ON THE STITCHING LINE AND BAG OUT THE PIECE.

IRON and Sew to the Body.











DON'T FORGET YOU CAN SWITCH AROUND THE COLOURS AND FABRICS HOWEVER YOU LIKE TO CREATE A WHOLE RANGE OF CROCHET LONG DOGS!
